### NOTICE OF RACE

**Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California**

#### 1. RULES:

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2 RRS 40.1 is deleted and replaced with: "All competitors shall wear life jackets or adequate personal buoyancy while racing. Note that Flag Y will not be displayed."

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to the following classes:

Melges 24, Etchells, Express 27, J/24

2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration at [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org).

2.3 The entry fee is \$75 for members of US SAILING and \$80 for non-members if received by May 12. A \$10 late fee will be assessed after May 12. Credit cards will be accepted using the online registration process. The option to charge club accounts is available to SFYC members only.

**4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:**

Sailing instructions will be available after May 12 at The San Francisco Yacht Club, and at [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org). Copies may also be obtained from the stern of the committee boat after it is anchored and until 1115 hours on race day.

**5. RACING AREAS AND COURSES:**

The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Berkeley Olympic Circle. The courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions.

**6. COMMUNICATIONS**

The Race Committee may communicate information about the regatta via VHF radio.

**7. ARBITRATION**

Arbitration will be in effect for protests involving a rule of RRS Part 2.

**8. SCORING:**

Three (3) races are scheduled, of which two (2) races must be completed to constitute a series. All races will count toward the final score.

**9. DOCKAGE:**

SFYC guest docks will be available from May 16-18, 2008.

**10. PRIZES:**

Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries received by May 12, 2008.
