2008 SUMMER KEELBOAT INVITATIONAL REGATTA 1D35, Express 37, and J/105 and J/105 Pacific Coast Championship

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1. RULES:

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2 RRS 40.1 will be deleted and replaced with: "All competitors shall wear life jackets or adequate personal buoyancy while racing." Note that Flag Y will not be displayed.

1.3 For the J/105 fleet, Fleet One Rules will be in effect, and this regatta will be conducted as the 2008 Pacific Coast Championship

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

2.1 The Summer Keelboat Regatta is open to the following classes: 1D35, Express 37, and J/105.

2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration at www.sfyc.org.

2.3 The entry fee for all classes is \$ 105.00 for US SAILING members and \$110.00 for others.

2.4 A \$10.00 late fee will be assessed to entries received after August 1.

2.5 Credit cards will be accepted using the online registration process. The option to charge yacht club accounts is available to SFYC members only.

2.6 One ticket for the Saturday evening BBQ will be included in the entry fee for all boats.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing instructions will be available after August 6, 2008, at The San Francisco Yacht Club, and at www.sfyc.org.

5. RACING AREA AND COURSES:

The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Berkeley Olympic Circle. The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

6. COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may use VHF radio to communicate information about course selection, time to start, the class position relative to the starting time, and the sail numbers of boats that are OCS.

7. SCORING:

Five (5) races are scheduled, of which, two (2) races must be completed to constitute a series. All races will count toward the final score.

8. PRIZES:

Summer Keelboat trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers in the 1D35 and Express 37 classes and the top five finishers in the J105 class.

The final trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on August 10.

9. BERTHING

Our guest docks will be available for racers from August 8-11, 2008.

10. PARKING

Parking in the SFYC lot will be restricted during the regatta. We will issue two parking passes per boat. We would appreciate all efforts to carpool or park off-site whenever possible. Passes may be picked up at the SFYC front desk on Friday, August 8, or at the lot on Saturday morning. Maps showing off-site parking locations will be available at www.sfyc.org.
