## Fall Classic Regatta

September 11 – 12, 2010

### NOTICE OF RACE

**Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California**

#### **1. RULES:**

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 40 will be changed as described in Section 7.

#### **2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following classes: IOD, Knarr, Folkboat, Bear.  
The Bird Boat fleet has been invited to use one of the races as their Bird Boat Perpetual.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration at [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org). If fewer than five (5) boats in a class are entered by September 7, SFYC may return the entry fees (minus a minimal processing charge) and not provide a start for that class.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$95 for members of US SAILING and \$100 for non-members if received by September 7. Entry fee will be \$105 and \$110 respectively if received after September 7. The entry fee includes one ticket for the Saturday evening barbecue on the deck. Additional tickets for the barbecue/dinner will be \$15.00 each.

#### **3. SCHEDULE OF RACES:**

#### **4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing instructions will be available after September 7 at The San Francisco Yacht Club, and on our web page, [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org).

**5. RACING AREA AND COURSES:**

The racing area will be in the vicinity of Point Knox. The courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions.

**6. COMMUNICATIONS**

The Race Committee may use VHF radio to communicate information about time to start and OCS boats.

**7. PERSONAL BUOYANCY**

RRS 40 is deleted and replaced with: "Competitors shall wear life-jackets or other adequate personal buoyancy while racing, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment." Note that Flag Y will not be displayed.

**8. SCORING:**

Four races are scheduled for the IOD, Knarr, Folkboat and Bear classes, of which two races must be completed to constitute the series. All races will count toward a series score.

**9. ARBITRATION**

Arbitration will be in effect for protests involving a rule of RRS Part 2.

**10. DOCKAGE**

SFYC guest docks will be available from September 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

**11. PRIZES:**

Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries received by September 7. The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on Sunday, September 12.

**12. PARKING**

Parking in the SFYC lot will be restricted during the regatta. We will issue two parking passes per boat, which can be used for personal vehicles. Passes may be picked up at the SFYC Front Desk on Friday, September 12, or at the lot on Saturday morning. We would appreciate all efforts to carpool or park off-site whenever possible.
