THE INAUGURAL SFYC/AYC CORINTHIAN CUP

October 22-23, 2010

NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

- 1.1. The Organizing Authority (OA) will be the San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California, in conjunction with the Joint Committee of the SFYC/AYC Corinthian Cup.

2. VENUE

- 2.1. The venue will be the San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere California.

3. PROVISIONAL SCHEDULE

- 3.1. Racing days October 23-24
- 3.2. Skipper's Boat Inspection October 23 at 0830 hours
- 3.3. Competitor's Meeting October 23 at 0930 hours
- 3.4. First race October 23 at 1200 hours
- 3.5. Event dinner October 23 at 1800 hours

4. RULES

- 4.1. This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *the Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) including Appendix C, the *Declaration of Trust and Conditions Governing the SFYC/AYC Corinthian Cup* (Declaration of Trust).

5. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 5.1. One team each from the San Francisco Yacht Club and the Annapolis Yacht Club are invited.
- 5.2. All competitors shall be classified as ISAF category Group 1.

6. BOATS AND SAILS

- 6.1. The event will be sailed in Etchells class boats.
- 6.2. Two boats will be provided by the SFYC.

- 6.3. The following sails will be provided for each boat: one mainsail, one jib and two spinnakers.
- 6.4. Boats will be allocated by drawing at the Competitor's Meeting.
- 6.5. Boats will be rotated every second race throughout the regatta. In the event that one of the provided boats is owned by a competing skipper and that skipper draws his own boat, the boats will be rotated after the first race and then after every second race.

7. CREW (INCLUDING SKIPPER)

- 7.1. The number of crew (including skipper) shall be 3 or 4. All crew shall sail in all races.
- 7.2. The maximum total crew weight (in light clothing), determined prior to racing shall be 285kg.

8. EVENT FORMAT

- 8.1. No more than seven races are scheduled unless ordered by the Joint Committee or Umpires.
- 8.2. The first yacht to be awarded 4 points under RRS C10 will win the regatta.
- 8.3. In the event a yacht is awarded 3 points during the first day's racing, the trailing skipper may choose to defer starting additional races to Sunday, October 24 at a time agreeable to the Joint Committee.

9. COURSE

- 9.1. The course will be windward/leeward with starboard roundings, finishing downwind.
- 9.2. The intended racing area will be the Berkeley Olympic Circle.
