SUMMER KEELBOAT INVITATIONAL REGATTA

August 14-15, 2010

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 40 is deleted and replaced with: "All competitors shall wear life jackets, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices." Note that Flag Y will not be displayed.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following classes:
- Express 37, J/105
- 2.2 If any fleet has fewer than 5 boats registered by August 10, SFYC may return the entry fee (minus a processing charge) and not provide a start for that class.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration at www.sfyf.org.
- 2.4 The entry fee for US SAILING members is \$100. Non-members of US SAILING must add \$5. A \$10 late fee will be assessed after August 10th.

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES:

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing instructions will be available after August 10th at The San Francisco Yacht Club, and at www.sfyc.org. Copies may also be obtained from the stern of the committee boat after it is anchored and until 1045 hours on race day.

5. RACING AREAS AND COURSES:

The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Berkeley Olympic Circle. The courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions.

6. COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may communicate information about the regatta via VHF radio.

7. ARBITRATION

Arbitration will be in effect for protests involving a rule of RRS Part 2.

8. SCORING:

Five (5) races are scheduled, of which two (2) races must be completed to constitute a series. All races will count toward the final score.

9. DOCKAGE:

SFYC guest docks will be available from August 13th-15th, 2010.

10. PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries received by August 10th, 2010.

11. SOCIAL EVENTS

12. PARKING: Parking in the SFYC lot will be restricted during the regatta. We will issue two parking passes per boat, which can be used for personal vehicles. Passes may be picked up at the SFYC Front Desk on Friday, August 13, or at the lot on Saturday morning. We would appreciate all efforts to carpool or park off-site whenever possible.
