Fall Classic Regatta

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1. RULES:

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 40 is deleted and replaced with: "Competitors shall wear life-jackets or other adequate personal buoyancy while racing, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment." Note that Flag Y will not be displayed.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following classes: IOD, Knarr, Folkboat, Bear, Bird, AE28
- 2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration at www.sfyc.org. If fewer than five (5) boats in a class are entered by October 7, SFYC may return the entry fees (minus a minimal processing charge) and not provide a start for that class.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$85 for members of US SAILING and \$90 for non-members if received by October 7. Entry fee will be \$95 and \$100 respectively if received after October 7.

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES:

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available after October 11 at The San Francisco Yacht Club, and on our web page, www.sfyc.org.

5. RACING AREA AND COURSES:

The racing area will be in the vicinity of Point Knox. The courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions.

6. COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may use VHF radio to communicate information about time to start and OCS boats.

7. SCORING:

Four races are scheduled, of which two races must be completed to constitute the series. No races will be excluded in determining the final scores.

8. ARBITRATION

Arbitration will be in effect for protests involving a rule of RRS Part 2.

9. DOCKAGE

SFYC guest docks will be available from October 14-16, 2011.

10. PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries received by October 7. The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on Sunday, October 16.

11. PARKING

Parking in the SFYC lot will be restricted during the regatta. We will issue two parking passes per boat, which can be used for personal vehicles. Passes may be picked up at the SFYC Front Desk on Friday, October 14, or at the lot on Saturday morning. We would appreciate all efforts to carpool or park off-site whenever possible.
