INVITATIONAL RESIN REGATTA

April 9-10, 2011

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1. RULES:

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2 RRS 40 will be deleted and replaced with the following: "All competitors shall wear life jackets or adequate personal buoyancy while racing." Note that Flag Y will not be displayed.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

2.1 The regatta is open to the following classes:

Antrim 27, Melges 24, Etchells.

2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration found at www.sfyc.org.

2.3 The entry fee is \$80 for members of US SAILING and \$85 for non-members, if received by April 5. A \$20 late fee will be charged after April 5. Refunds, if necessary, will be minus a minimal processing fee.

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES:

3.1 The first warning signal will be at 1130 Hours on both Saturday and Sunday.

3.1.1 For the Antrim 27 and Etchells classes, 3 races are scheduled on Saturday and 2 races are scheduled on Sunday.

3.1.2 For the Melges 24 class, 6 races are scheduled on both Saturday and Sunday.

3.2 On each day, subsequent races will be started as soon as possible following the previous race.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing instructions will be available after April 5, 2010, at The San Francisco Yacht Club, and on our web page, www.sfyc.org.

5. RACING AREA AND COURSES:

The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Olympic Circle. The courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions. All marks will be inflatable buoys.

6. COMMUNICATIONS:

The Race Committee may use VHF radio to communicate information about time to start and OCS.

7. SCORING:

Two races must be completed to constitute a series. All races will count toward the final score.

8. PRIZES:

Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries.
