## **2011 Spring Invitational Regatta**

**June 4-5, 2011**

### **NOTICE OF RACE**

**Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California**

#### **1. RULES:**

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The rules of J/105 Fleet One will be in effect.

1.2 RRS 40 is deleted and replaced with: "All competitors shall wear life jackets or adequate personal buoyancy while racing." Note that Flag Y will not be displayed.

#### **2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:**

2.1 The regatta is open to the following fleets: J/120, J/105, Express 37, and Melges 24

2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration at [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org).

2.3 The entry fee is \$95 for members of US SAILING and \$99 for non-members, if received by May 31, 2011. A \$25 late fee will be assessed after May 31. One ticket to the Saturday evening barbecue is included in each entry.

#### **3. SCHEDULE OF RACES:**

#### **4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:**

Sailing instructions will be available after June 1, 2011, at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on our website, [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org).

5. **RACING AREA AND COURSES:** The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Olympic Circle. The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.
6. **COMMUNICATIONS:** The Race Committee may communicate information about the regatta via VHF radio.
7. **SCORING:** Six (6) races are scheduled, of which two (2) must be completed to constitute a series. When fewer than six races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. If six races are completed, each boat's worst score will be excluded.
8. **ARBITRATION:** Arbitration will be in effect for protests involving a rule of RRS Part 2.
9. **DOCKAGE:** The SFYC guest dock will be available from June 3 through June 5.
10. **PRIZES:** Prizes will be awarded based on the number of boats entered in each class. The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on Sunday.
