SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2 RRS 40 is deleted and replaced with: "All competitors shall wear life jackets or adequate personal buoyancy when racing." Note that Flag Y will not be displayed.

1.3 RRS 44.1 is changed as follows: A boat may take a penalty when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 or Rule 31. The penalty shall be a One-Turn Penalty unless she may have broken a rule of Part 2 within the zone of a rounding or finishing mark, in which case the penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors and changes in the sailing instructions or schedule will be posted on the official notice board, located under the tent by the Youth flagpole in the SFYC parking lot, prior to 1100 hours on the day they are to take effect.

3 SCHEDULE OF RACES

The warning signal for the first race will be at 1200 noon. Each succeeding race will start shortly after the finish of the previous race. Racing will take place in the vicinity of Raccoon Strait.

4 COURSES AND MARKS

Attachment A describes the marks and shows the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

5 THE START AND FINISH

The start/finish line will be between an orange flag on the race committee boat and Mark X. Races will be started using the Sound-Signal Starting System of RRS Appendix S.

6 COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may use VHF channel 72 to communicate information about the races. Neither failure of the Race Committee to communicate the sail numbers of recalled boats in a timely manner nor failure of recalled boats to receive or hear transmitted information will be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.

7 PROTESTS

Protests shall be delivered to the PRO within 30 minutes after the committee boat returns to the dock. The return time will be posted on the official notice board.

8 SCORING

Five races are scheduled, of which two races must be completed to constitute a series. All races will count toward the final score.

9 PRIZES

The Hart Nunes Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the regatta. First and second place keeper trophies will be awarded as well. The awards presentation will be held under the tent by the SFYC Youth flagpole following the racing.

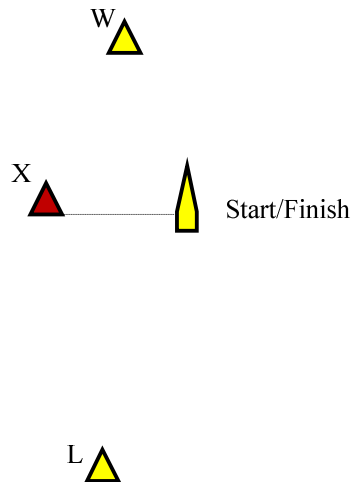

Marks

- PS – Pt. Stuart Bell Buoy**
- W – Yellow Inflatable set as Weather Mark**
- L – Yellow Inflatable set as Leeward Mark**
- X – Red Inflatable Start/Finish Line Mark**

All marks are rounding marks except X when it is at the Start or Finish.

Courses

Note: If Flag “G” is displayed, substitute PS for W.

- 1 – Start – W(p) – L(p) – Finish**
- 2 – Start – W(p) – L(p) – W(p) – L(p)– Finish**
- 3 – Start – W(p) – Finish**
- 4 – Start – W(p) – X(p) – W(p) - Finish**
- 5 – Start – W(p) – L(p) – W(p) – Finish**
- 6 – Start – W(p) – X(p) – W(p) – L(p) – Finish**
