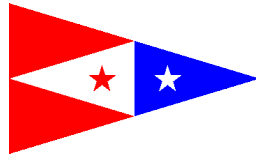

Fall Classic Regatta

October 11 – 12, 2014

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Appendix T Section A (PENALTIES WHILE RACING) shall apply for the following classes: IOD, Knarr, Folkboat, Bear and Bird.
- 1.3 Appendix T Section B (POST RACE PENALTIES) shall apply.
- 1.4 All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except for brief periods while changing or adjusting clothing. The Y flag will not be flown. This changes rule 40.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following classes: IOD, Knarr, Folkboat, Bear, Bird, AE28
- 2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration at www.sfyc.org > On the Water > Racing > Schedule. If fewer than five (5) boats in a class are entered by 1700 on October 8, SFYC may return the entry fees and not provide a start for that class.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$120 if received by 1700 hours on October 8. A late fee of \$50 will be assessed after October 8.

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available after 1700 hours on October 9 at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on our web page, www.sfyc.org.

5. RACING AREA AND COURSES

The racing area will be in the vicinity of Point Knox. The courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions.

6. COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may use VHF channel USA 65A to communicate information about time to start and OCS boats.

7. SCORING

Four (4) races are scheduled, of which two races must be completed to constitute the series. No races will be excluded in determining the final scores.

8. DOCKAGE

SFYC guest docks will be available from October 10 - 12.

9. PRIZES

The Delmas and Delmas Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the IOD fleet. Keeper trophies for all fleets will be awarded based on the number of boats entered. The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on Sunday, October 12.

10. PARKING

Parking in the SFYC lot will be restricted during the regatta. We will issue two parking passes per boat, which can be used for personal vehicles. Passes may be picked up at the SFYC Race Office on Friday, October 10, or at the entrance to the lot on Saturday morning. We would appreciate all efforts to carpool or park off-site whenever possible.
