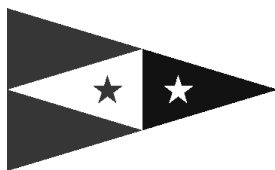

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Appendix T Section B (Post Race Penalties) shall apply.
- 1.3 Appendix T Section C (Expedited Hearings) shall apply.
- 1.4 All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except for brief periods while changing or adjusting clothing. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors and changes in the sailing instructions or schedule will be posted on the official notice board, located on the deck of the SFYC, prior to 1100 hours on the day they are to take effect.

3 SCHEDULE OF RACES

The warning signal for the first race will be at 1200 noon. Each succeeding race will start shortly after the finish of the previous race.

4 COURSES AND MARKS

- 4.1 **Attachment A** describes the marks and shows the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.
- 4.2 The course to be sailed will be displayed using numeral pennants displayed on the race committee boat.

5 THE START AND FINISH

The start/finish line will be between an orange flag on the race committee boat and Mark L. Races will be started using the Sound-Signal Starting System of RRS Appendix S (3 minutes).

6 COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may use VHF channel 65 to communicate information about the races and boats observed OCS at the start. Neither failure of the Race Committee to communicate the sail numbers of OCS boats in a timely manner, nor failure of OCS boats to receive or hear transmitted information shall be grounds for redress.

7 PROTESTS

Protests shall be delivered to the PRO within 30 minutes after the committee boat returns to the dock. The return time will be posted on the official notice board.

8 SCORING

Five races are scheduled, of which two races must be completed to constitute a series. All races will count toward the final score.

9 PRIZES

The Hart Nunes Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the regatta. First and second place keeper trophies will be awarded as well. The awards presentation will be held under the tent by the SFYC Youth flagpole following the racing, or on the SFYC deck.

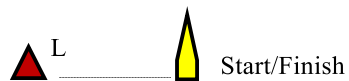

Marks

W – Yellow Inflatable set as Weather Mark

L – Red Inflatable set as Leeward Mark

**All marks are rounding marks, except L when it is at the Start or Finish.
All rounding marks shall be left to port.**

Courses

1 – Start – W – Finish

2 – Start – W – L – W – Finish

3 – Start – W – L – W – L – W – Finish
