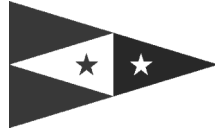

2014 SFYC Multihull Regatta

June 14-15, 2014

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The class rules of each class will also be in effect.
- 1.2 Appendix T Section B (POST RACE PENALTIES) shall apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following fleets: F18, Weta, and A-cat.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration at www.sfyc.org.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$80.
- 2.4 If fewer than 5 boats in a class are entered by 1500 hrs on June 12, SFYC may refund the entry fees and not provide a start for that class.

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available after June 11, 2014, at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on our website, www.sfyc.org.

5. RACING AREA AND COURSES

On Saturday the racing area will be in the vicinity of the north Berkeley Olympic Circle. On Sunday the racing area will be offshore of Fort Knox, west of Angel Island. The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

6. COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may communicate information about the regatta via VHF 65.

7. SCORING

7.1 Six races are scheduled, of which two must be completed to constitute a series.

7.2 Scoring will use the Low Point System of Appendix A.

7.3 If five or more races are completed a boat's series score will be total of her race scores excluding her worst. If fewer than five races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8. DOCKAGE

8.1 The south end of the parking lot will be available for boat storage on trailers from June 13 through 16.

8.2 Guestdock space will be available for boats that wish to stay in the water on Saturday night.

9. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded based on the number of boats entered in each class. The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on Sunday.
