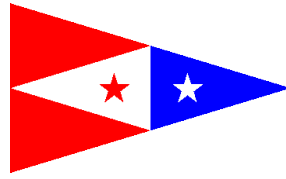

2014 ROUND THE ISLAND RACE Saturday, October 18, 2014

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 40 is deleted and replaced with "All competitors shall wear life jackets or adequate personal buoyancy while racing." Note that Flag Y will not be displayed.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all keel boats 18 feet and over of The San Francisco Yacht Club. All boats must be skippered by SFYC members.
- 2.2 Boats must be entered in either the Spinnaker or Non-Spinnaker Division, although all boats will start together. Boats eligible to race in the Non-Spinnaker Division are boats rated with spinnakers that will race without the spinnakers or other exotic sails. Boats designed without spinnakers will be scored in the Spinnaker Division.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration at www.sfyc.org. There is no entry fee for this regatta. All entries must be complete by 1700 hours on October 17, 2014. **As this is not a Club Championship Series race, all boats must register.**

3. BURGEE

All boats must fly the SFYC burgee. The race committee will add a five-minute penalty to the finish time for boats failing to comply.

4. SCHEDULE

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available after 1700 hours on October 15, 2014 at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on our web page, www.sfyc.org.

6. RACING AREA AND COURSE

The race will start off Belvedere Cove, then leave Treasure Island to port, Southampton Platform to port, and to the finish line off Corinthian Yacht Club.

However, due to the dismantling of the cantilever (east section) of the Bay Bridge, the race course may change. Further information will be provided in the sailing instructions.

7. COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may use VHF Channel USA 65A to communicate information about time to start and OCS.

8. SCORING

Finishing positions will be established by corrected time, using Time on Time corrections, as determined by San Francisco Bay PHRF handicaps.

9. PRIZES

9.1 The Round the Island Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the overall first place finisher on corrected time, with keeper trophies awarded to the first through third place finishers in both Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker divisions.

Trophies will be presented on the Club deck after the race.

9.2 Family Challenge certificates will be presented in both divisions, with a \$20.00 Waypoint Pizza gift certificate awarded for the best corrected time in each division, after a 10 second/mile credit is given for each crew member between the ages of 5 and 18, or over 80. The Family Challenge calculations will not affect overall race results.
