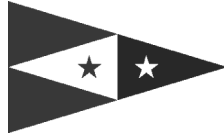

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. Appendix T Section B (Post Race Penalties) shall apply.
- 1.3. For the Melges 24 and Melges 20 classes, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One Turn Penalty.
- 1.4. For the Etchells and Open 5.70 class, Appendix T Section A (Penalties While Racing) shall apply, and will be stated in the sailing instructions.
- 1.5. All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except for brief periods while changing or adjusting clothing. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. The Y flag will not be displayed. This changes rule 40.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats in the Melges 24, Melges 20, Etchells, J/24, Cal20, and Open 5.70 classes.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration found at www.sfyc.org.
- 2.3. The entry fee is \$120 for the series.
- 2.4. The entry fee for a single day is \$50.

3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

Saturday: May 3, May 31, and June 28

1130 Warning signal for first race. Additional race(s) to follow ASAP.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available after May 28 at The San Francisco Yacht Club, and on the SFYC website, www.sfyc.org.

5. VENUE AND COURSES

The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Berkeley Circle or Southampton. The

courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions.

6. SCORING

The series will be scored according to RRS Appendix A2 and A9. Each regatta will have three (3) races scheduled. Four (4) races must be completed to constitute a series.

7 COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may use VHF radio channel 65 to communicate information about time to start and boat observed OCS.

8 PRIZES

Series trophies will be awarded for first and second place in each fleet at the completion of the series. There will be no Corinthian Team trophies.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
