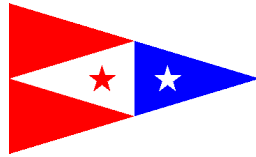

## FALL CLASSIC REGATTA

October 10 – 11, 2015

### NOTICE OF RACE

**Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California**

#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Appendix T Section A (PENALTIES WHILE RACING) shall apply for the following classes: IOD, Knarr, Folkboat, Bear and Bird.
- 1.3 Rule 40 is changed to: All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except for brief periods while changing or adjusting clothing. Flag Y will not be flown.

#### **2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following classes: IOD, Knarr, Folkboat, Bear, Bird, AE28
- 2.2 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online registration found at [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org) > On the Water > Racing > Schedule. If fewer than five (5) boats in a class are entered by 1700 on October 9, SFYC may return the entry fees and not provide a start for that class.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$120 if received by 1700 hours on October 7. The fee will become \$170 after 1700 hours on October 7.
- 2.4 No entries will be accepted after 1700 hours on October 9.

#### **4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing instructions will be available after 1700 hours on October 8 at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on our web page, [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org).

## **5 RACING AREA AND COURSES**

The racing area will be in the vicinity of Point Knox. The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

## **6 COMMUNICATIONS**

- 6.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
- 6.2 The Race Committee may use VHF USA channel 65A to communicate information about the races.

## **7 SCORING**

- 7.1 Four (4) races are scheduled. Two (2) races must be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. No scores will be excluded.

## **8 DOCKAGE**

SFYC guest docks will be available from October 9 - 12.

## **9 PRIZES**

Keeper trophies for all fleets will be awarded based on the number of boats entered. The Delmas and Delmas Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the IOD fleet. The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after racing on Sunday, October 11.

## **10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
