NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Appendix T Section C (EXPEDITED HEARINGS) shall apply.
- 1.3 Rule 40 is changed to: All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except for brief periods while changing or adjusting clothing. Flag Y will not be displayed.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Mercury Class sailboats. This will be a counter in the Travel Trophy Series.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing the online registration at www.sfyc.org > On the Water > Racing > Schedule.
- 2.3 If fewer than five (5) Mercury Class boats are entered by June 19, SFYC will cancel the regatta and return the entry fees.
- 2.4 The entry fee is \$25.00. No entries will be accepted after 1200 hours on June 19.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available on June 18 at SFYC, online at www.sfyc.org, and at the Competitors' Meeting.

5 VENUE

The racing area will be in Raccoon Strait or Knox.

6 COURSES AND MARKS

The courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions.

7 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The Race Committee may use VHF USA channel 65A to communicate information about the races.

8 SCORING

Five races are scheduled. Two races must be completed to constitute a series. All races will count toward the final score.

9 PRIZES

The Hart Nunes Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the regatta. First and second place keeper trophies will be awarded as well. The awards presentation will be held under the tent by the SFYC Youth flagpole following the racing.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
