SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Appendix T Section C (EXPEDITED HEARINGS) shall apply.
- 1.3 Rule 40 is changed to: All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except for brief periods while changing or adjusting clothing. Flag Y will not be displayed.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board, located on the deck of The SFYC.

3 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 hours on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 1800 hours on the day before it will take effect.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Saturday, June 20

1000-1100 hours	Launching
1100 hours	Competitors' Meeting
1200 hours	First Warning Signal
- 4.2 Five races are scheduled. Each succeeding race will start shortly after the finish of the previous race.

5 CLASS FLAG

The class flag will be numerical pennant one.

6 RACING AREA

The racing area will be in Raccoon Strait.

7 COURSE AND MARKS

The courses and marks are described in Attachment A.

8 THE START AND FINISH

- 8.1 The start/finishing line will be between an orange flag on the race committee signal boat and a red inflatable mark, in the vicinity of Keil Cove.
- 8.2 Races will be started using the Sound-Signal Starting System of RRS Appendix S.

9 TIME LIMITS

- 9.1 The time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish each race is 60 minutes.
- 9.2 Boats failing to finish within 15 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing. This changes rules 35, A4 and A5.

10 PROTESTS

- 10.1 Protests, requests for redress and requests to reopen a hearing shall be in writing in a US Sailing protest form and shall be delivered to the PRO. US Sailing protest forms are available at the front desk. This changes RRS 61.2
- 10.2 The protest time is 30 minutes after the race committee signal boat docks. The time limit will be posted on the official notice board.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 Five races are scheduled. Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2 A boat's series scores will be the total of her races scored. No scores will be excluded.

12 COMMUNICATIONS

- 12.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction applies to mobile telephones.
- 12.2 The race committee may use VHF USA channel 65A to communicate information about the races.

13 PRIZES

The Hart Nunes Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the regatta. First and second place keeper trophies will be awarded as well.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in a regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

SOCIAL EVENT

Saturday, June 20 – The awards presentation will be held under the tent by The SFYC Youth flagpole following the racing. The hospitality of the Club is available to all participants and their families.

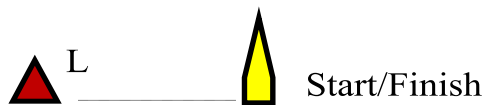
PARKING

Marks

PS – Pt. Stuart Bell Buoy

W – Yellow inflatable set as Weather Mark

L – Red inflatable set as Leeward Mark (same as Start/Finish mark)

All marks are rounding marks except L when it is the Start or Finish.
All roundings shall be left to port.

Courses

Note: If flag “G” is displayed, substitute PS for W.

1 – Start – W - Finish

2 – Start – W – L – W – Finish

3 – Start – W – L – W – L – W - Finish
