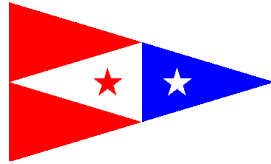

## 2015 June Invitational Regatta

June 6 - 7, 2015

### NOTICE OF RACE

**Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California**

#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Appendix T Section A (PENALTIES WHILE RACING) shall apply.
- 1.3 Appendix T Section B (POST RACE PENALTIES) shall apply.
- 1.4 Rule 40 is changed to: All competitors shall wear personal flotation device while racing, except for brief periods while changing or adjusting clothing. Flag Y will not be displayed.

#### **2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following fleets: J/105, J/111 and J/120.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration at [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org) > On the Water > Racing > Schedule.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$120, if received by 1800 hours on June 3. The entry fee will become \$170 after 1800 hours on June 3.
- 2.4 No entries will be accepted after 1800 hours on June 5.
- 2.5 If fewer than 5 boats in a class are entered by 1400 hours on June 5, SFYC may refund the entry fee and not provide a start for that class.

#### **3 SCHEDULE OF RACES**

- 3.1 The first warning signal will be at 1200 hours on both Saturday and Sunday. Three (3) races are scheduled on Saturday and two (2) races are scheduled on Sunday.
- 3.2 On each day, subsequent races will be started as soon as possible following the previous race.

#### **4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing instructions will be available after June 3, 2015, at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on our website, [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org).

## **5 RACING AREA AND COURSES**

The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Berkeley Olympic Circle. The courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions. All marks will be inflatable buoys.

## **6 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

The Race Committee may use USA VHF channel 65A to communicate information about the races.

## **7 SCORING**

7 Two races must be completed to constitute a series.

7.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. No scores will be excluded

## **8 BERTHING**

The SFYC guest dock will be available from June 5 through June 7.

## **9 PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded based on the number of boats entered in each class.

## **10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **11 PARKING**

Parking in the SFYC lot will be restricted during the regatta. We will issue two parking passes per boat. Passes may be picked up at the Race Office or at the entrance to the SFYC parking lot on Saturday morning. We would appreciate all efforts to carpool or park off-site whenever possible.
