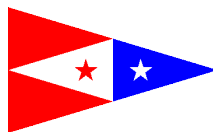

2015 SFYC Multihull Regatta

August 1-2, 2015

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Rule 40 is changed to: All competitors shall wear a personal flotation device while racing, except for brief periods while changing or adjusting clothing. Flag Y will not be displayed.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following fleets: F18 and Weta.
- 2.2 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online registration at www.sfyc.org > On the Water > Racing > Schedule.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$80, if received by 1800 hours on July 29. The entry fee will become \$100 after 1800 hours on July 29.
- 2.4 No entries will be accepted after 1500 hours on July 31.
- 2.4 If fewer than 5 boats in a class are entered by 1500 hrs on July 31, SFYC may refund the entry fees and not provide a start for that class.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available on July 29 at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on our website, www.sfyc.org.

5 RACING AREA AND COURSES

- 5.1 On Saturday, August 1, the racing area will be in the vicinity north of the Berkeley Olympic Circle.
- 5.2 On Sunday, August 2, the racing area will be offshore of Fort Knox, west of Angel Island.
- 5.3 The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

6 COMMUNICATIONS

- 6.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
- 6.2 The Race Committee may use VHF USA channel 65A to communicate information about the races.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 Six races are scheduled. Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2 If five or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be total of her race scores excluding her worst. If fewer than five races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8 DOCKAGE

Guest dock space will be available for boats that wish to stay in the water on Saturday night.

9 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded based on the number of boats entered in each class. The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on Sunday.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
