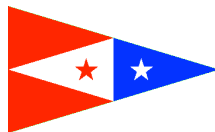

July 23 – 24, 2016

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Rule 40 is changed as follows: All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions may change additional racing rules.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following fleets: F18 and Weta.
- 2.2 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online registration at www.sfyc.org > On the Water > Racing > Schedule.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$80, if received by 1700 hours on July 20. The entry fee will become \$100 after 1700 hours on July 20.
- 2.4 No entries will be accepted after 1600 hours on July 22.
- 2.4 If fewer than 5 boats in a class are entered by 1700 hrs on July 20, SFYC may refund the entry fees and not provide a start for that class.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on July 20 at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on our website, www.sfyc.org.

5 RACING AREA AND COURSES

- 5.1 On Saturday the racing area will be in the vicinity north of the Berkeley Olympic Circle.
- 5.2 On Sunday the racing area will be offshore of Fort Knox, west of Angel Island.
- 5.3 The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

6 SCORING

- 6.1 Six races are scheduled. Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 6.2 If five or more races are completed, a boat's series score will be total of her race scores excluding her worst.
- 6.3 If fewer than five races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

7 BERTHING

The guest docks will be available for boats that wish to stay in the water on Saturday night.

8 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 8.1 Competitors should monitor VHF USA channel 65A for on the water communication with the race committee.
- 8.2 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

9 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded based on the number of boats entered in each class. The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after the racing on Sunday.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

PARKING

Parking in the SFYC lot will be restricted during the regatta. We will issue two parking passes per boat, and one of these may be used for a trailer. The south end of the parking lot will be available for boat storage on trailers from July 22 through July 25.
