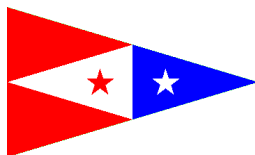

## FALL CLASSIC REGATTA

October 14 – 15, 2017

### NOTICE OF RACE

**Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California**

#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Rule 40 is changed to: All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except for brief periods while changing or adjusting clothing. Flay Y will not be flown.
- 1.3 Appendix V1 (Penalty at the Time of an Incident) shall apply.

#### **2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following classes: IOD, Knarr, Folkboat, Bear, Bird, Alerion Express 28.
- 2.2 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online registration found at [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org) > On the Water > Racing > Regatta Schedule.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$135, if received by 1700 hours on October 11. The entry is \$185 after 1700 hours on October 11.
- 2.4 No entries will be accepted after 1600 hours on October 13.
- 2.5 If fewer than five (5) boats in a class are entered by 1600 on October 13, SFYC may return the entry fees and not provide a start for that class.

#### **4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available after 1700 hours on October 11 at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on the website, [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org).

**5 RACING AREA AND COURSES**

The racing area will be in the vicinity of Point Knox. The courses will be described in the sailing instructions.

**6 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS**

6.1 The race committee may use VHF USA channel 65A to communicate information about the races.

6.2 Except in an emergency or when retiring from a race, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats.

**7 SCORING**

7.1 Four (4) races are scheduled. Two (2) races must be completed to constitute as series.

7.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. No scores will be excluded.

**8 DOCKAGE**

SFYC guest docks will be available from October 13 - 15.

**9 PRIZES**

Keeper trophies for all classes will be awarded based on the number of boats entered in each class.

The Delmas and Delmas Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the IOD fleet. The trophy presentation will be held on the SFYC deck after racing on Sunday October 15.

**10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
