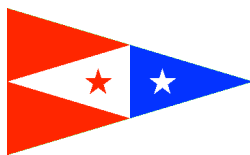

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Appendix V1 (Penalty at the Time of the Incident) shall apply.
- 1.3 Rule 40 is changed as follows: All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located outside on the west wall of the SFYC Clubhouse. The NOR, SIs, and amendments thereto will be posted online at www.sfyc.org.

3 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 1800 on the day before it will take effect.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Saturday, July 8

1000-1100 hours	Launching
1100 hours	Competitors' Meeting at Youth picnic area
1200 hours	First Warning Signal, additional races to follow
After Racing	Trophy Presentation at Youth picnic area
- 4.2 Five (5) races are scheduled. Each succeeding race Warning will start shortly after the finish of the previous race.
- 4.3 No Warning signal will be made after 1700 hours.

5 CLASS FLAG

The class flag will be Flag W.

6 RACING AREA

The racing area will be in Raccoon Strait.

7 COURSES AND MARKS

- 7.1 The courses and marks are described in Attachment A.

7.2 The course to be sailed will be indicated by a numeral pennant.

8 THE START AND FINISH

The start and finishing line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee signal boat and a red inflatable mark, in the vicinity of Keil Cove.

9 TIME LIMITS

9.1 The time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish each race is 60 minutes.

9.2 Boats failing to finish within 15 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. This changes rules 35, A4 and A5.

10 PROTESTS

10.1 Protests, requests for redress and requests to reopen a hearing shall be in writing on a US Sailing protest form, available at the front office of the Clubhouse. Protest forms should be delivered to the SFYC Race Office. This changes rule 61.2

10.2 The protest time is 30 minutes after the race committee signal boat docks. The time limit will be posted on the official notice board.

11 SCORING

11.1 Two races must be completed to constitute a series.

11.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. No scores will be excluded.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

12.1 The race committee may use VHF USA channel 65A to communicate information about the races.

12.2 The race committee will attempt to hail boats observed OCS at the start. The failure of any boat to hear the hail, the hail of some but not all OCS boats, the untimely hail of some or all OCS boats, or failure to hail any or all boats shall not be grounds for redress. This changes rule 62.

12.3 Except in an emergency or when retiring from a race, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

13 PRIZES

The Hart Nunes Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the regatta. First and second place keeper trophies will be awarded as well.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death, sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta.

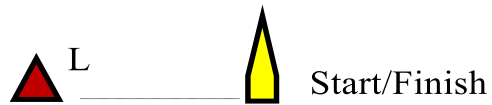

Marks

W – Yellow inflatable set as Weather Mark

L – Red inflatable set as Leeward Mark (same as Start/Finish pin)

All marks are rounding marks except L when it is part of the Starting or Finishing Line.
All rounding marks shall be left to port.

Courses

1 – Start – W – Finish

2 – Start – W – L – W – Finish

3 – Start – W – L – W – L – W – Finish
