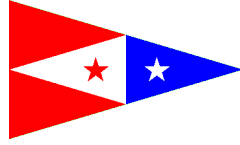

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Appendix V1 (Penalty at the Time of an Incident) shall apply.
- 1.3 Rule 40 is changed as follows: All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed.
- 1.4 The sailing instructions may change additional racing rules.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Mercury Class sailboats. This regatta will be a counter in the Travel Trophy Series.
- 2.2 Eligible boats shall enter online at www.SFYC.org under On the Water > Regatta Schedule and pay by credit card, by 1000 hours on July 7.
- 2.3 The entry fee is \$25.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on July 4 on The San Francisco Yacht Club website at www.sfyc.org and at the Competitors' Meeting on July 7.

5 VENUE

The racing area will be in Raccoon Strait or Richardson Bay, depending on conditions and forecast.

6 COURSES AND MARKS

The courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 Five races are scheduled.
- 7.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. No scores will be excluded.

8 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 8.1 Competitors should monitor VHF USA channel 65A for on the water communication with the race committee.
- 8.2 Except in an emergency or when retiring from a race, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

9 PRIZES

The Hart Nunes Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the regatta.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
