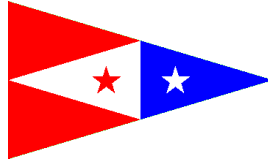

JUNE INVITATIONAL REGATTA

June 16 - 17, 2018

NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 The rules for J/120 Fleet Five and J/105 Fleet One will be in effect for those respective classes.
- 1.3 Rule 40 is changed as follows: All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed.
- 1.4 Appendix T Section A (PENALTIES WHILE RACING) shall apply for all classes except the Melges 24 class.
- 1.5 The sailing instructions may change additional racing rules.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The following classes are invited:
J/111, J/120, Express 37, J/105, Melges 24, Express 27
- 2.2 J/105 Fleet 1 will require on-site crew weigh-in. The Fleet will manage the weigh-ins upstairs in the Sailing Center at the following times, or as set by the Fleet Measurer or their designee.

Friday, June 15	1700-1800 hours
Saturday, June 16	0930-1000 hours
Sunday, June 17	0930-1000 hours
- 2.3 Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online registration found at www.sfyc.org > On the Water > Regatta Schedule.
- 2.4 The entry fee is \$135, if received by 1700 hours on June 13. The entry is \$185 after 1700 hours on June 13.
- 2.5 No entries will be accepted after 1600 hours on June 15.
- 2.6 If fewer than 5 boats in a class are entered by 1700 hours on June 13, SFYC may refund the entry fee and not provide a start for that class.

3 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 3.1 Saturday, June 16 – Three (3) races are scheduled with the first warning signal at 1200 hours.
- 3.2 Sunday, June 17 – Two (2) races are scheduled with the first warning signal at 1200 hours.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available on June 13, at The San Francisco Yacht Club and on the website, www.sfyc.org.

5 VENUE

The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Berkeley Olympic Circle.

6 COURSES AND MARKS

The courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions. All marks will be inflatable buoys.

7 PENALTY SYSTEM

For the Melges 24 class, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

8 SCORING

8.1 Two races must be completed to constitute a series.

8.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. No scores will be excluded

9 BERTHING

The SFYC guest dock will be available from June 15 through June 17.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

10.1 Competitors should monitor VHF USA channel 65A for on the water communication with the race committee.

10.2 Except in an emergency, or when retiring from a race, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded based on the number of boats entered in each class.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
