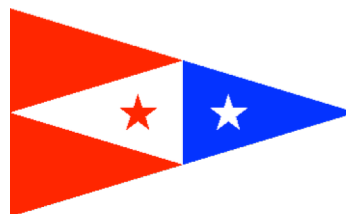


**2014 Leukemia Cup Youth Regatta**

**Sailing Instructions**



**1 Rules**

- 1.1 The regatta is organized by The San Francisco Yacht Club. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), the Optimist Class Rules, and the Notice of Race, except in the event that any of these are modified by these Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 All participants in this regatta must wear a **US Coast Guard approved** Type III personal flotation device (PFD) at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while adding or removing other clothing. Violation of this rule will result in a penalty by the Race Committee up to disqualification from the entire regatta.

**2 Changes to the Sailing Instructions**

Any changes to the sailing instructions will be made orally on shore or on the water to all competitors.

**3 Schedule of Events**

1100-1200 ..... Registration at SFYC Youth picnic tables  
1200-1230 ..... Pizza Lunch  
1300 ..... First Start in Cove  
1530 ..... No races started after this time  
1600 ..... Awards at youth picnic tables, or Leukemia Cup tent

**4 Courses and Racing Area**

The courses will be windward/leewards and triangles. Courses will be explained on shore and on the water by the Race Committee. Racing will take place in Belvedere Cove.

**5 Marks**

The marks will be orange balls.

**6 The Start**

- 6.1 Races will be started using RRS Appendix S (3-minute sound signals.)
- 6.2 The starting line will be between an orange flag on the RC boat and a nearby mark.

**7 The Finish**

The finish line will be the same as the starting line.

**8 Scoring and Prizes**

The low point scoring system will be used. All races will count towards the series score (no throwouts.) All race participants will receive an award.

**9 Disclaimer of Liability**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the event.
