NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California

1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Rule 40 is changed to: All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except for brief periods while changing or adjusting clothing. Flag Y will not be displayed.
- 1.3 Spinnakers will not be used in the regatta.
- 1.4 The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to women members of The San Francisco Yacht Club.
- 2.2 Current Northern California PHRF certificates shall be submitted to the SFYC Race Office prior to racing. For any boat that does not have a current NCPHRF certificate, a NCPHRF will be assigned at the sole discretion of the race committee. Assigned ratings will not be grounds for redress.
- 2.3 All boats must be owned or chartered by a SFYC member and all crew members must be SFYC women members.
- 2.4 Eligible boats shall register at <u>www.sfyc.org</u> > On the Water > Racing> Schedule. Only online entries will be accepted. There will be no entry fee for this regatta.
- 2.5 No entries will be accepted after 1800 hours on Oct 23.

3 SCHEDULE

- 3.1 One race will be sailed on October 25.
- 3.2 The first warning will be at 1200 hours.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at SFYC and on the Club website by Thursday, October 22.

5 COURSE AND MARKS

- 5.1 The race course will be in the vicinity of Knox.
- 5.2 The courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions.

6 SCORING

Scoring for the race will be PHRF Time-on-Time.

7 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 7.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
- 7.2 The race committee may us VHF USA channel 65A to communicate information about the races.

8 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded based on the number of entries. A perpetual trophy will be awarded and will be kept at SFYC. Keeper prizes will be awarded to each winner.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death, sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
