

# **2017 Spinnaker Cup**

## **Information and Registration Instructions**

The 2017 Spinnaker Cup will be part of the California Offshore Race Week for the second year. Integration with this larger event has required some registration and schedule adjustments from previous years. The Spinnaker Cup as a stand-alone race will continue to exist, although the start has been moved to Saturday. - The course will be the same as in previous years.
- Downwind ratings will be used if the average wind is behind 90 degrees to the course rhumb line. This will be further outlined in the NOR, and was the same in 2016.
- All boats shall comply with the Minimum Offshore Requirements (MOR) as specified by the Northern California Offshore Racing Council. The MOR can be found on the web at [www.norcalorc.org](http://www.norcalorc.org), 2017 Gear List. (The four-hour (half-day) Coastal Safety at Sea Seminar does not qualify for MOR requirement 4.3.2)
- A life raft is not required, but must be carried if the boat is continuing on in the Series.
- The entry fee will be \$150, with a \$100 late fee after 1800 hours on May 19.
