## The J120/Express 37 Regatta June 5 & 6, 2010

### NOTICE OF RACE

**Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, Belvedere, California**

#### 1. RULES:

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS 40 is deleted and replaced with: "All competitors shall wear life jackets or adequate personal buoyancy while racing." Note that Flag Y will not be displayed.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following classes:

J120 and Express 37

- 2.2 Eligible boats may be entered by completing online registration at [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org).

- 2.3 The entry fee is \$90 for members of US SAILING and \$95 for non-members if received by June 1<sup>st</sup>. A \$20 late fee will be assessed after June 1<sup>st</sup>. Refunds, if necessary, will be minus a minimal processing fee.

#### 3. SCHEDULE OF RACES:

#### 4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Sailing instructions will be available after June 1<sup>st</sup> at The San Francisco Yacht Club, and at [www.sfyc.org](http://www.sfyc.org). Copies may also be obtained from the stern of the committee boat after it is anchored and until 1145 hours on race day.

**5. RACING AREAS AND COURSES:**

The racing area will be in the vicinity of the Berkeley Olympic Circle. The courses and marks will be described in the sailing instructions.

**6. COMMUNICATIONS**

The Race Committee may communicate information about the regatta via VHF radio.

**7. ARBITRATION**

Arbitration will be in effect for protests involving a rule of RRS Part 2.

**8. SCORING:**

Five races are scheduled of which two races must be completed to constitute a series. All races will count toward the final score.

**9. DOCKAGE:**

SFYC guest docks will be available from June 4-6, 2010.

**10. PRIZES:**

Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries received by June 1, 2010.

**11. PARKING**

Parking in the SFYC lot will be restricted during the regatta. We will issue two parking passes per boat. Passes, and offsite parking maps, may be picked up at the SFYC Front Desk on Friday, June 4, 2010, or at the lot on June 5<sup>th</sup>.
